

Dear Homeowner,

Maricopa County offers an expedited permitting process to help property owners repair or restore structures damaged by fire to previous conditions. This process involves two steps:

- Compliance Inspection: The property owner submits a request for a compliance inspection for fire damage. A county inspector visits the site, assesses the damage, and documents the necessary repairs. These notes are shared with the property owner.
- 2. <u>Alteration Permit Application</u>: After the inspection, the property owner applies for an alteration permit to carry out the repairs. These permit applications are prioritized for faster review. The plan reviewer uses the inspector's notes to ensure all necessary repairs are included in the submittal.
